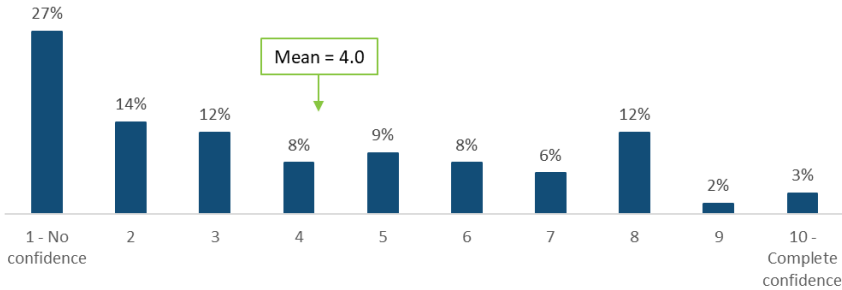

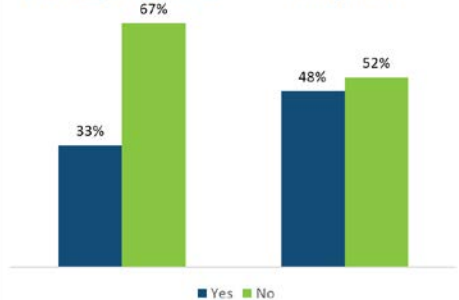

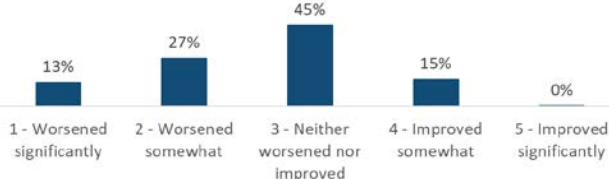
As an Indigenous person, how much confidence do you have when contacting the Police/RCMP when you require their services?



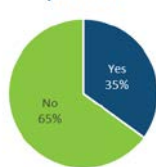
In your day-to-day life, do you feel safer when you see the Police/RCMP around? During a crisis, do you feel safer when you see the Police/RCMP?



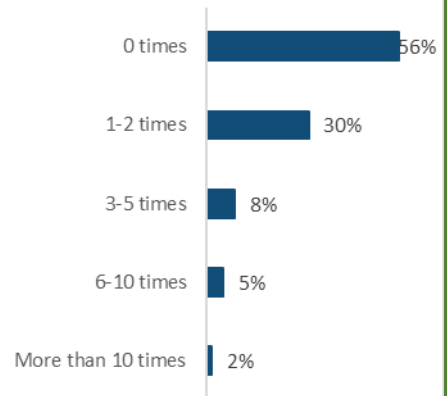
Has the Indigenous peoples' relationship with Police/RCMP improved or worsened as a result of the introduction of Reconciliation and Calls to Action?



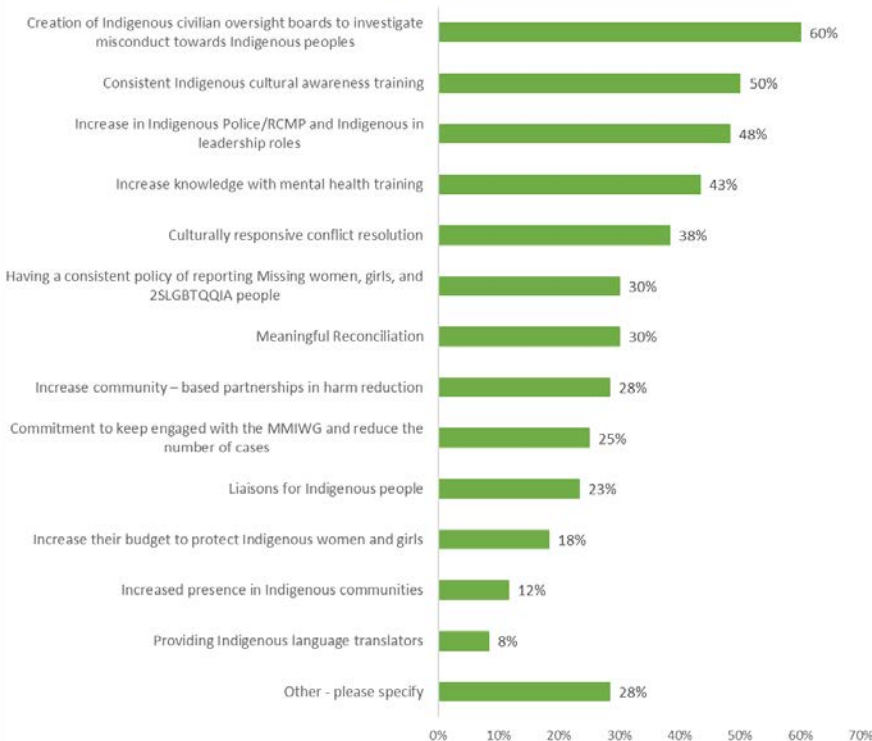
Have you ever made a complaint about the Police/RCMP in your area?
